PAR Lettres Patentées du Roy données à Fontainebleau le cinquième jour du mois d'Octobre, l'An de Grâce mil six cent quatre - vingt - quinze, Signées , LOUIS : & sur le replis , Par le Roy , PHELYPEAUX ; Scellées du grand Sceau de cire jaune : Confirmées par Lettres de Surrannation, données à Marly le vingt-huitième May mil sept cent quinze , Signées comme dessus : Toutes lesdites Lettres Verifiées & Registrées en Parlement le 7. Juin 1715. Il est permis ( à J.-B- Christophe Ballard , seul Imprimeur du Roy pour la Musique , & Noteur de la Chapelle de Sa Majesté ,) d'Imprimer , faire Imprimer , Vendre & Distribuer toute sorte de Musique , tant Vocale qu'Instrumentale , de quelque Auteur ou Auteurs que ce soit , avec très-expreses inhibitions & deffenses à tous Imprimeurs , Libraires , Tailleurs & Fondeurs de Caractères , & autres personnes , généralement quelconques , de Tailler , Fondre , ni contrefaire les Notes , Caractères Lettres grises , & autres choses inventées par ledit Ballard ; ny d'entreprendre ou faire entreprendre ladite Impression de Musique , en aucun lieu de ce Royaume , Terres & Seigneuries de l'obéissance de Sa Majesté , nonobstant toutes Lettres à ce contraires ; sans le congé & permission dudit Ballard ; à peine de confiscation des Livres ou Exemplaires , Notes , Caractères & autres Instruments servant au fait de ladite Impression de Musique , & de six mille livres d'amande ; Ainsi qu'il est plus amplement declaré esdites Lettres : Sadite Majesté voulant qu'à l'Extrait d'icelles mis au commencement ou fin desdits Livres imprimez , foy soit ajoutée comme à l'Original.
