in the MS there is a rhythmical figure which occurs in several bars (6, 8, 10, 12 and 14)
with 2 demisemiquavers followed by a semiquaver tied to a quaver, tied to a minim. In
bar 6 this figure is changed in the right hand to 2 semiquavers followed by a quaver tied
to a minim, and in all the following bars an "obs" is written. I interpret this as a change
to the latter rhythm in alla instances.
the 6th tone in the right hand probably lacks a natural accidental
this section is put in brackets, has many corrections and is generally difficult to read
the chord in the left hand is notated as semibreve, but as the time is ¾ it should be a
punctuated minim
over the notes in the last beat of the right hand stands "19" though there are 14 notes
v. h. Abbreviation for "vänster hand", left hand
