The third movement of Symphony no. 84 by Joseph Haydn is a nice Menuet and Trio. It is not difficult at all, but care has to be taken to play the many occurrences of a sixteenth followed by dotted eight correctly. There are some fast register changes in the first voice (but not in the other voices).
